About this manual

In these cases the player may not respond to all operating commands. When this occurs, please refer to the instructions in the disc inlay. When a "∅" appears on the screen, the operation is not permitted by the player or the disc.

Remote control operation

- Unless otherwise stated, all operations can be carried out with the remote control. Always point the remote control directly at the player, making sure there are no obstructions in the path of the infrared beam.
- When there are corresponding keys on the main unit, they can also be used.

Menu navigation

- Your player has an intuitive menu navigation system to guide you through various settings and operations.
- Use the function keys to activate / disable relevant operations.
- Use **▲**, **▼**, **◀**, **▶** to browse through menus.
- Press **OK** key to confirm your selection.

Changing the audio output (for VCD/CD)

Playing a DVD disc

After switching on, inserting the disc and closing the door, playback starts automatically. The screen shows the type of disc loaded. The disc may invite you to select an item from a menu. Use the **▲, ▼, ◀, ▶** keys to highlight your selection, and press **OK**.

Note: Since it is usual for DVD movies to be released at different times in different regions of the world, all players have region codes and discs can have an optional region code. If you load a disc of a different region code to your player, you will see the region code notice on the screen. The disc will not play, and should be unloaded.

Playing an audio or video CD disc

- After switching on, inserting the disc and closing the door, playback starts automatically. The screen shows the type of disc loaded as well as information about the disc's contents.
- While playing VCD with MTV/Karaoke, press number keys(0-9) to select the track and press **▶II** or **OK** to play the track. Press **TITLE/RETURN** to go back to menu of the selection.

Playing DivX® disc

- Philips provide you the DivX® VOD (Video on Demand) registration code that allows you to rent and purchase videos using the DivX® VOD service. For more information, visit www.divx.com/vod.
- Select the DivX® VOD on the Video Setup Page.
- The registration code will appear.

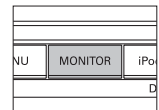

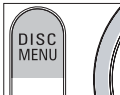

After connecting your iPod player as described in the "Connections" section, you can play files stored in the iPod player with ►◄ ◀ ▶ (search backward/forward) and ◀ ▶ / ►► keys on the DVD player or keys on your iPod player directly.

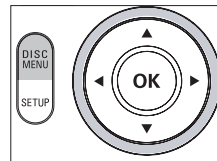
TIP

- To recharge your iPod player, you must connect the DVD player to AC mains or the car cigarette lighter outlet. If your iPod player is in the power-on status, make sure the currently selected source of the DVD player is "DOCK".
- Please take out the tab marked "for 30G iPod" in the dock if you want to dock a 60G or 80G iPod player.
- It is impossible to recharge your iPod with the built-in battery of the DVD player.
- Make sure to recharge your iPod player below 35°C.
- After switching on your iPod player, set "TV OUT" to "ON" and select the "NTSC" mode. To play photos in your iPod player, you need to press ►◄ on your iPod player. Otherwise, there will be no picture on the TFT screen when you play video files in your iPod player. (See your iPod user's manual for detailed operation.)
- For photos stored in your iPod player, only the ►◄ key is available.

If a fault occurs, first check the points listed, before taking the set for repair. If you are unable to solve a problem by following these hints, consult your dealer or service centre.

Symptom	Remedy
No power	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Check if both plugs of the mains cord are properly connected. – Check if there is power at the AC outlet by plugging in another appliance. – Check if the built-in battery is drained. – Check if car adaptor is connected appropriately.
Distorted picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Check the disc for fingerprints and clean with a soft cloth, wiping from centre to edge. – Sometimes a small amount of picture distortion may appear. This is not a malfunction.
Completely distorted picture / no colour in the TV screen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – The NTSC setting may be in the wrong status. Match your TV's setting with the player's setting.
No sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Check audio connections. If using a HiFi amplifier, try another sound source.

Disc can't be played	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Ensure the disc label is upwards. – Clean the disc. – Check if the disc is defective by trying another disc.
The player does not respond to the remote control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Aim the remote control directly at the sensor on the front of the player. Avoid all obstacles that may interfere with the signal path. Inspect or replace the batteries.
Distorted or B/W picture with DVD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Use only discs formatted according to the TV-set used (NTSC).
Player does not respond to all operating commands during playback	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Operations are not permitted by the disc. – Refer to the instructions in the disc inlay.
Player feels warm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – When the player is in use for a long period of time, the surface will be heated. This is normal.
Display goes dimmer when AC is unplugged	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – The unit is saving power to ensure longer playtime with battery. It is normal. Adjust the brightness using the rotary brightness control.
