

Preparation for firmware update:


- 1. Ensure your Airplay speaker is connected to the same network as your Apple device.
- 2. Turn on the speaker.
- 3. Wait until there is a beep sound and the LED indication turns solid green

If your speaker is not setup yet, please follow below steps:

- 1. Connect your iPod touch/iPhone/iPad to your home Wi-Fi network.
- 2. Connect your iPod/iPhone/iPad to the main speaker through an Apple USB cable (not supplied).



3. Press WI-FI SETUP button on the back of the main speaker

5. There will be a prompt if a new firmware is found, then tapb "Next"



6. Following the on screen instructions to complete the upgrade. It will take around 5 mins

If you cannot upgrade via SoundStudio App, please upgrade your speaker with computer.

For update via computer:

• Your device is connected to your Wi-Fi network as same as your computer

Update Procedure:

Step 1: Download the latest firmware


1. Click on the Download icon at the top of the screen to download the new firmware package with extension .fw to your computer.



Note: Please DO NOT rename either the folder name or the file name in the folder to avoid an update corruption.


Step 2: Update your speaker with computer

- 1. Power on your speaker, if you hear a beep sound or find the LED is in green color after 1minute, please go to **step 8** directly. Otherwise, please go to point 2.
- 2. Connect your iPod touch/iPhone/iPad to your home Wi-Fi network.
- 3. Connect your iPod/iPhone/iPad to the main speaker through an Apple USB cable (not supplied).



4. Press WI-FI SETUP button on the back of the main speaker


