→ You only need this driver for your USB storage device when using Windows 98 Second Edition.

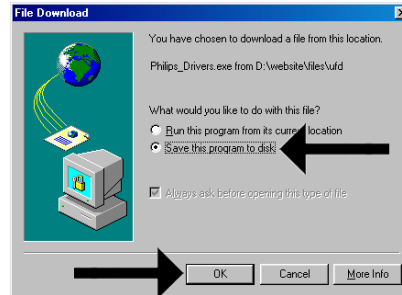

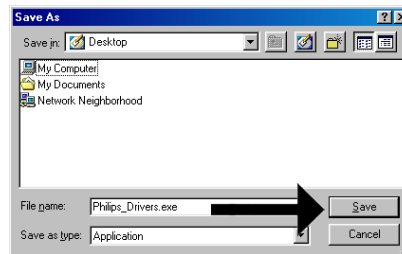
Choose "Save this program to disk" and "OK".

Click on "Save".

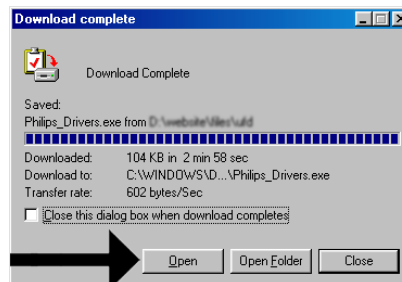
 The file will be saved on your desktop.

Click "Open" ..

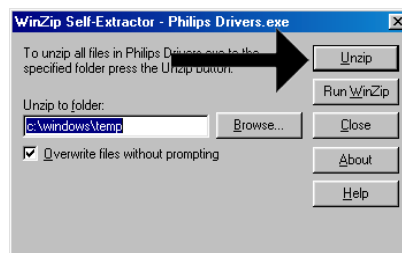
 If this does not appear, double click the "Philips_Drivers.exe" on your desktop.

Click "Unzip".

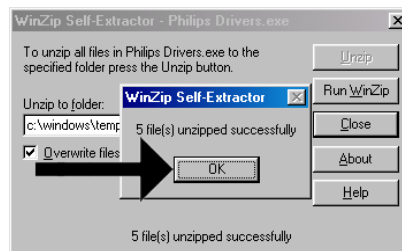
 We advise not to change the folder.

Click "OK" and "Close".



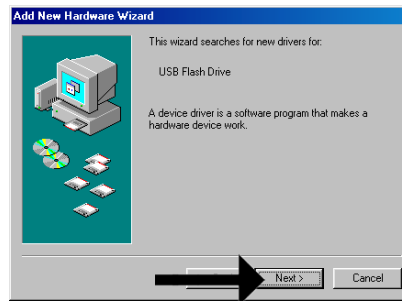

 We advise to use a USB2.0 HiSpeed Port to enjoy all capabilities of your Philips USB storage device.



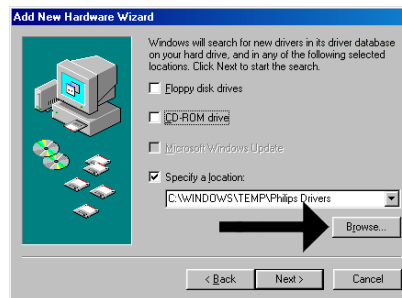
8 The Add New Hardware Wizard will pop up.

9 Click "Next".

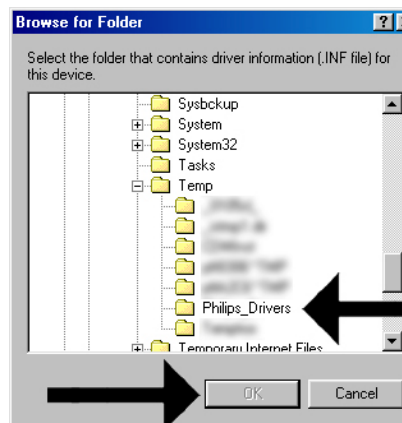


10 Click "Browse".

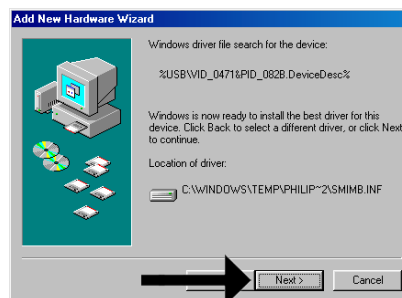


11 Go to C:\Windows\Temp\Philips_Drivers
