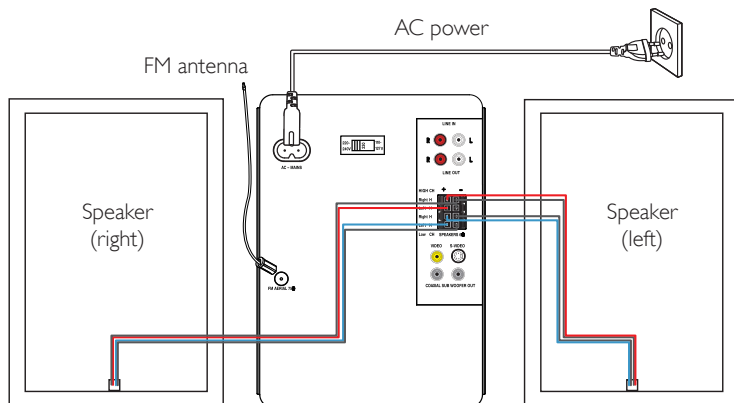

Step A **Connect**

- 1 Connect the speaker cables.
- 2 Connect the AC power cord to AC~MAINS jack on the main unit, and the wall socket.

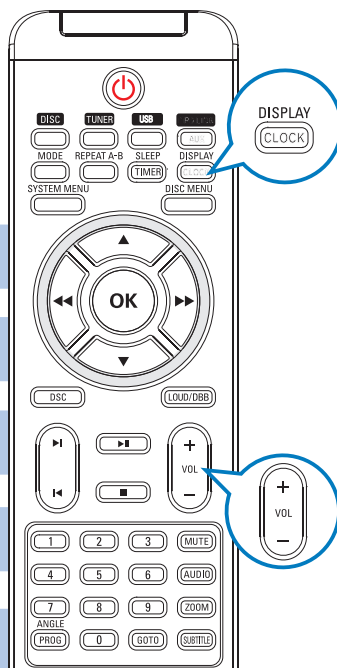

Step B **Setup**

Setting the clock

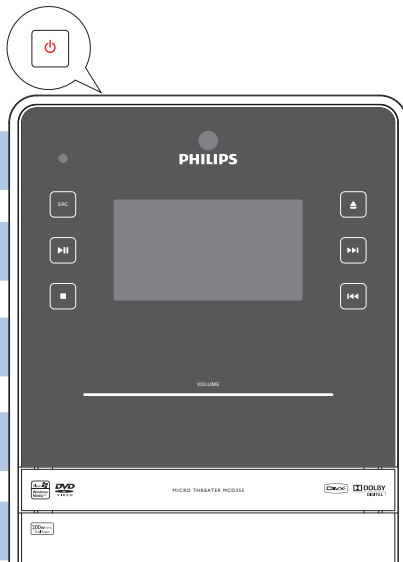
- 1 In standby mode, press and hold **CLOCK/DISPLAY**.
- 2 Press **VOL+/-** to set the hour.
- 3 Press **CLOCK/DISPLAY** to confirm.
- 4 Press **VOL+/-** to set the minute.
- 5 Press **CLOCK/DISPLAY** again to confirm the time setting.



Step C Enjoy


Playing a disc

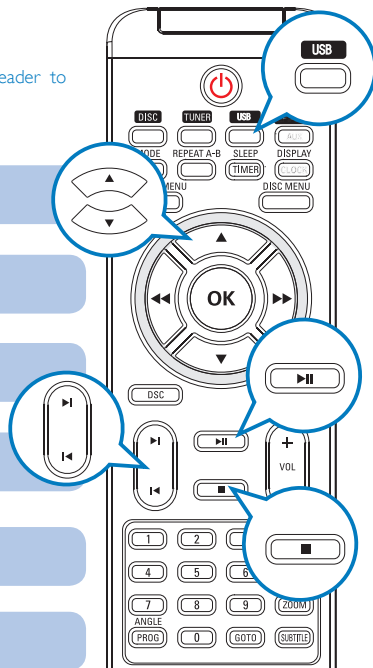
- 1 Press **DISC** to select DISC.
- 2 Press **▲** to open the disc compartment.
- 3 Insert a disc with the printed side facing up, then close the disc door.
- 4 Playback will start automatically. If not, press **▶II**.
- 5 To stop playback, press **■**.



Playing a USB mass storage device

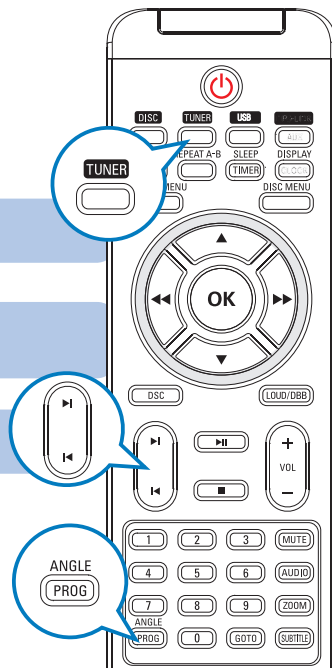
With the apparatus, you can use USB flash memory (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), USB flash players (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), memory cards (requires an additional card reader to work with this apparatus).

- 1 Insert the USB device's USB plug into the socket  on the main unit.
- 2 Press **USB**.
- 3 Press **▲▼** to select a folder.
- 4 Press **◀/▶** to select a file.
- 5 Press **▶II** to pause or resume play.
- 6 To stop play, press **■**.



Programming and tuning to radio stations

- 1 Press **TUNER** to select tuner source.
- 2 Press **PROG/ANGLE** for more than two seconds to program all available stations in order of waveband.
- 3 Press **◀** or **▶** until the desired preset station is displayed.
