

## **■** Important

Read this user manual carefully before you use the appliance and save it for future reference.

## Warning

- Keep the appliance dry.
- This symbol means: Forbidden to clean with water (Fig. 2).
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

#### Caution

- Use and store the appliance at a temperature between 5°C and 35°C.
- Remove the batteries from the appliance if you are not going to use it for a month or more.
- Use Philips batteries to achieve optimal shaving performance.
- Only use the cleaning brush supplied.
- Make sure the cleaning brush remains clean.

## Electromagnetic fields (EMF)

This Philips appliance complies with all standards regarding electromagnetic fields (EMF). If handled properly and according to the instructions in this user manual, the appliance is safe to use based on scientific evidence available today.

## ■ Preparing for use

## Inserting the batteries

The appliance operates on two R6 AA 1.5-volt alkaline batteries. Preferably insert new Philips alkaline batteries to get optimal shaving performance.

Make sure that your hands are dry when you insert the batteries.

- 1 Remove the lid of the battery compartment (Fig. 3)
- 2 Place two batteries in the battery compartment (Fig. 4).

Note: Make sure the + and - indications on the batteries match the indications in the battery compartment.

Note: The shaver does not work if the batteries have been placed incorrectly.

2 Put the lid of the battery compartment back onto the appliance. First place the top part of the lid (1) and then press down the bottom part until you hear a click (2) (Fig. 5).

## How to avoid damage due to battery leakage

- Do not expose the appliance to temperatures higher than 35°C.
- Remove the batteries if you are not going to use the appliance for a month or more.
- Do not leave empty batteries in the appliance.

## Shaving time

Two new Philips alkaline batteries offer a shaving time of 60 minutes.

## Using the appliance

- 1 Remove the protection cap.
- 2 Press the on/off slide to unlock it and push it upwards to switch on the shaver (Fig. 6).

The on/off slide has an integrated switch lock to prevent accidental switching on of the shaver.

Move the shaving heads over your skin. Make both straight and circular movements (Fig. 7).

Note: Shave on a dry face only. Do not use the shaver in combination with gel, foam or water.

Note: Your skin may need 2 or 3 weeks to get accustomed to the Philips shaving system.

- 4 Push the on/off slide downwards to switch off the shaver.
- 5 Clean the shaver after every shave, see chapter 'Cleaning and maintenance'.
- 6 Put the protection cap on the shaver after use to prevent damage and to avoid dirt accumulation in the shaving heads (Fig. 8).

## Cleaning and maintenance

Never use scouring pads, abrasive cleaning agents or aggressive liquids such as petrol or acetone to clean the appliance.

Clean the shaver after every shave to guarantee better shaving performance. For the best cleaning result, we advise you to use Philips Cleaning Spray (HQ110). Ask your Philips dealer for information.

Note: Philips Shaving Head Cleaning Spray (HQ110) may not be available in all countries. Contact the Customer Care Centre in your country about the availability of this accessory.

## After every shave: shaving unit and hair chamber

- 1 Switch off the shaver.
- 2 Clean the top of the appliance with the cleaning brush supplied (Fig. 9).
- 3 Press the release button (1) and pull the shaving unit a straight up off the shaver (2) (Fig. 10).
- 4 Clean the inside of the shaving unit with the cleaning brush (Fig. 11).
- 5 Clean the hair chamber with the cleaning brush (Fig. 12).
- 6 Put the shaving unit back onto the shaver (Fig. 13).

#### Every two months: shaving heads

Note: Do not use cleaning agents or alcohol to clean the shaving heads. Only use Philips Cleaning Spray (HQ110).

- 1 Switch off the shaver.
- Press the release button (1) and pull the shaving unit straight up off the shaver (2) (Fig. 10).
- 3 To remove the retaining frame, push the sides of the central spring towards each other (1). Then lift the retaining frame out of the shaving unit (2) (Fig. 14).
- 4 Slide the shaving heads out of the retaining frame. Remove and clean one shaving head at a time. Each shaving head consists of a cutter and a guard (Fig. 15).

Note: Do not clean more than one cutter and guard at a time, since they are all matching sets. If you accidentally mix up the cutters and guards, it may take several weeks before optimal shaving performance is restored.

- 5 Remove the guard from the cutter (Fig. 16).
- 6 Clean it with the short-bristled side of the cleaning brush. Brush carefully in the direction of the arrows (Fig. 17).
- 7 Clean the guard with the long-bristled side of the cleaning brush (Fig. 18)
- 8 Put the cutter back into the guard after cleaning (Fig. 19).
- 9 Slide the shaving heads back into the retaining frame. (Fig. 20)
- 10 Put the retaining frame back into the shaving unit ('click') (Fig. 21).
- 11 Put the shaving unit back onto the shaver (Fig. 13).

## ■ Storage ■

Keep the appliance dry.
Use and store the appliance at a temperature between 5°C and 35°C.

- 1 Switch off the shaver.
- 2 Put the protection cap on the shaver after use to prevent damage and to avoid dirt accumulation in the shaving heads (Fig. 22).

## ■ Replacement ■

Replace the shaving heads every two years for optimal shaving results.

Replace damaged or worn shaving heads with Philips shaving heads only (HQ4+ for China or HQ56 for the rest of the world). For instructions on how to remove the shaving heads, see chapter 'Cleaning and maintenance', section 'Every two months: shaving heads'.

#### Accessories

To retain the top performance of your shaver, make sure you clean it regularly and replace its shaving heads at the recommended time.

## Shaving heads

 We advise you to replace your shaving heads every two years. Always replace them with Philips shaving heads only (HQ4 for China or HQ56 for the rest of the world) (Fig. 23).

## Cleaning

 Use Philips Cleaning Spray (HQ110) to clean the shaving heads thoroughly.

#### Environment

- Do not throw away the appliance with the normal household waste at the end of its life, but hand it in at an official collection point for recycling. By doing this, you help to preserve the environment (Fig. 24).
- Batteries contain substances that may pollute the environment. Do not throw away batteries with the normal household waste, but dispose of them at an official collection point for batteries. Always remove the batteries before you discard and hand in the appliance at an official collection point (Fig. 25).

## **Troubleshooting**

The shaver does not work when I push the on/off slide upwards.	The batteries are placed incorrectly.	Make sure the + and - indications on the batteries match the indications in the battery compartment.

## ■■使用准备■■

#### 插入电池

本产品使用两节 R6 AA 1.5 伏碱性电池。最好插入全新的飞利浦碱性电池,以实现最佳的剃须效果。

## 装入电池之前,双手要保持干燥。

- 1 取下电池仓盖(图3)
- 2 将两节电池放入电池仓。(图 4)

注意: 确保电池的正负极指示与电池仓内的正负指示一致。

注意: 如果电池装错方向,则剃须刀就不会工作。

3 将电池仓盖装回到产品。首先放入 仓盖的顶部(1),然后按下底部(2) ,直到听到"咔哒"一声。(图 5)

如何避免因电池泄漏而引起的损坏 切勿将产品暴露在温度高于35°C

## 剃须时间

两节全新飞利浦碱性电池可供 60 分钟 剃须。

## ■■使用本产品■

- 1 取下保护盖。
- 2 按开/关滑钮将其解锁,然后向上推 打开剃须刀电源。 (图 6)

开/关滑钮具有集成式开关锁,可防止意 外打开剃须刀电源。

3 将剃须刀头在皮肤上移动。作直线 和迂回动作。(图 7)

注意: 仅限在干爽的面部剃须。请勿 将本剃须刀与凝胶、剃须泡沫或水结 合使用。

- 4 向下推动开/关滑钮以关闭剃须刀电源。

## ■■清洁和保养■■

不要使用钢丝球、研磨性清洁剂或腐蚀性液体(例如汽油或丙酮)来清洁 产品。

每次剃须后均应清洁剃须刀,以保证更 好的剃须效果。

- 2 用随附的清洁刷清洁产品顶部。 (图 9)
- 3 按释放按钮 (1), 垂直向上拉动剃须 刀头部件,将其从剃须刀 (2)中拉 出。(图 10)
- 4 用清洁刷清洁剃须刀头部件的内侧。(图 11)
- 5 用清洁刷清洁胡茬储藏室。(图 12)
- 6 将剃须刀头组件重新安装到剃须刀 上。(图 13)

每两个月: 清洁剃须刀头

注意: 请勿使用清洁剂或酒精来清洁 剃须刀头。只能使用飞利浦清洁喷雾剂 (HQ 110)。

- 1 关闭剃须刀。
- 2 按释放按钮 (1), 垂直向上拉动剃须 刀头部件,将其从剃须刀 (2)中拉 出。(图 10)
- 3 要取下固定架,请捏拢中央弹簧的两侧(1)。然后向上提起固定架,将其从剃须刀头部件中取出(2)。(图 14)
- 4 将剃须刀头滑离固定架。一次取下 并清洁一个剃须刀头。每个剃须刀 头包含一组刀片和网罩。(图 15)

注意: 不要同时清洁多组刀片和网罩, 因为它们都是相互匹配的。如果不小心 将刀片和网罩弄混,则需要数周时间才 能恢复产品的最佳剃须性能。

5 从刀片上卸下网罩。(图 16)

- 6 用清洁刷的短毛一侧清洁刀片。 按箭头方向小心地清洁。(图 17)
- 7 用清洁刷的长毛一侧清洁网罩。 (图 18)
- 8 清洁后,将刀片重新装回至网罩。 (图 19)
- 9 滑动剃须刀头,将其重新安装到固 定架上。 (图 20)
- 10 将固定架重新安装到剃须刀头部件 上(可听到"咔嗒"一声)。 (图 21)
- 11 将剃须刀头组件重新安装到剃须刀 上。(图 13)

#### ■■存储■■

保持器具干燥。

必须在 5°C 至 35°C 之间的温度下使用和存放本产品。

- 1 关闭剃须刀。
- 2 使用后请盖上剃须刀保护盖,以防止损坏剃须刀头并避免其内积聚灰 尘。(图 22)

## 更换■■
